RESOLUTION NO. 305 -S2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE MUNICIPAL MAYOR EDGAR S. SAN LUIS TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SANTA CRUZ, LAGUNA A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH JOHN JOSEPH RELOVA FUNERAL HOMES DULY REPRESENTED BY ETHEL RELOVA WITH PRESENT ADDRESS IN BARANGAY CALIOS, SANTA CRUZ, LAGUNA, AS SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF HUMAN REMAINS OF COVID-19 RELATED CASES IN THIS MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Santa Cruz, Laguna through the effort of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer (MDRRMO) in the performance of its tasks and functions, shall open continuously to performed specifically mitigation, prevention, preparedness, response rehabilitation and recovery during this time of surge;

WHEREAS, in order to perform such functions so as to support and promote the health and safety of the inhabitants in handling the remains of those affected or confirmed Covid-19 patients, the MDRRMO is hereby directed to forge agreements with private sector in order to ensure the necessary immediate services;

WHEREAS, after careful study and due evaluation of the Sangguniang Bayan, deemed it proper to grant an authority to Honorable Mayor Edgar S. San Luis to enter into Memorandum of Agreement with John Joseph Relova with the foregoing considerations:

- 1. That the Memorandum of Agreement shall be effective during the entire period of community quarantines and until the total lifting of covid related health emergency by the National Government.
- That the Municipal Government of Santa Cruz, Laguna agrees to pay the service provider in the amount of THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 35,000.00) for every service delivered chargeable to the 30% Quick Response Fund (QRF) of MDRRM Fund.
- 3. The mode of payment shall be on monthly basis upon submission of necessary documents.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Lucena R. Odejar (Chairman of Committee on Social Welfare and Development, Family and Women), duly seconded by Hon. Mark Anthony P. Joven, Hon. Ambiel John C. Panganiban, Hon. Ramon D. Tan and Hon. Efren L. Diaz and with the unanimous approval of the members of Sangguniang Bayan, it was

RESOLVED: To authorize the Honorable Municipal Mayor Edgar S. San Luis to enter and sign and in behalf of the Municipal Government of Santa Cruz, Laguna a Memorandum of Agreement with John Joseph Relova Funeral Homes duly represented by Ethel Relova with present address in Barangay Calios, Santa Cruz, Laguna, as Service Provider for the Management of Human Remains of Covid-19 related Cases in this Municipality.

ORDERED: Let copies of this resolution be furnished the Honorable Municipal Mayor, the Municipal Treasurer, the Municipal Budget Officer, the Municipal Accountant, the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator; the Municipal Health Officer, John Joseph Relova Funeral Homes and all other concerned offices, for their information and appropriate action.
