WHEREAS, many indigent residents of Santa Cruz are in need of medical assistance for hospitalization, laboratory procedures, surgeries, medications, and other health-related services which are financially burdensome for their families;

WHEREAS, the Medical Assistance for Indigent Patients (MAIP) Program, facilitated through the Office of the Senator, provides much-needed financial support to qualified beneficiaries who require medical treatment in government hospitals and health facilities;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive and the Sangguniang Bayan of Santa Cruz recognize the importance of strengthening partnerships with national government offices and elected officials to provide timely and adequate medical assistance to its people;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Jericho V. Asinas (Chairman of Committee on Health, Nutrition and Sanitation), duly seconded by all members of the Sangguniang Bayan present;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to respectfully request the HONORABLE SENATOR JINGGOY EJERCITO ESTRADA of the Republic of the Philippines to extend medical assistance under the MAIP (Medical Assistance for Indigent Patients) Program to qualified indigent patients and residents of the Municipality of Santa Cruz, Province of Laguna;
